



MORRISSEY: New attack ANGER AS HARRY IS ATTACKED

MORRISSEY has followed up his attack on Prince William with a verbal assault on his younger brother.

The former Smiths frontman took advantage of Harry's trip to Brazil to claim all the prince wanted to do was steal people's money.

He told fans at a concert in Rio de Janeiro as Harry launched an official drive to bring tourists to Britain at the city's landmark Sugarloaf Mountain: "As you know Harry is here."

Slogan

"He's come to take your money. Please don't give him any."

Earlier Morrissey dressed his band in T-shirts with the slogan 'We hate William and Kate' at a gig in Argentina.

He also stepped into the row over the Falklands - Las Malvinas in Spanish - by telling concert-goers in Buenos Aires: "We all know that the Malvinas are Argentina's."
